Five cars went off the tracks just east of 50th Street, north of the Yellowhead Trail just before rush hour Thursday morning.

Nobody was hurt in the incident and no railway crossings were blocked.

The cars did not contain any hazardous goods, said a CN spokesperson.

Crews will be on the scene for much of the day which could affect traffic in the area.
