CN Rail crews are cleaning up this morning following a train derailment last night near Canfor's Northwood Pulpmill. CN Spokesperson Kelli Svendson says the incident occurred around 8:30 last night.

"We had 11 loaded carrying lumber and pulp products derailing on a southbound train about ten miles north of Prince George."

Svendson says there were no injuries and the cause of the derailment is under investigation. She expects the tracks will be cleared and passable by later this evening.
