

PHOTOS: 33 train cars derail west of Raymore, Sask.

Only 1 car was carrying a dangerous good, no evacuations

First responders are gathering just outside of Raymore, Sask. where a train derailed Friday morning.

Two locomotives were pulling 135 cars west from Winnipeg when 33 of those cars left the track around 9:45 a.m. Only one of those cars were carrying a dangerous good.

"Preliminary indication, based on information from the crew, is that the car is intact and not leaking," explained Jim Feeny, director of public and government affairs for CN Rail.

The dangerous good was an alcohol product called isopropanol.

The other derailed cars were freight cars; 22 were carrying automobiles.

No one was hurt in the derailment and CN investigators are heading to the scene. RCMP say no one was evacuated.
